

Jo Ann's Camp Gear List
With additions from Adrian

- Tarp, preferably nylon, 9X12 (or larger if you can handle it – mine is 12x24) to set up over the kitchen if it rains.
- Rope for stringing up the tarp.
- Collapsible saw – folding
- Fire starters, waterproof matches, and few briquettes
- Cooking utensils (spoon, flipper and can opener), knives, cutting board, filleting knife
- Lined Gloves for the fire and hot pots
- Fire grate? – or fire box
- Water filter
- Water bucket – you can buy plastic collapsible pails that work great.
- Pails, to pack dry food with screw on lids – or pack barrels
- Small stove with 2 L of fuel as backup
- First aid kit for the group
- Cast iron pan – or Teflon pan and Teflon grill for pancakes and fish fries
- Cooking pots – preferably nesting sets of 3-4 pots. An outback oven is also a great investment.
- Foil for cooking and storing cooked food for lunch the next day
- Extra ziploc bags, garbage bags
- Sewing kit
- Small shovel
- Wash basin – I like to take 2 nested together, one for dishes (dirty) and to make biscuits in (clean)
- Camp suds, scrapers, Molly Mop (for that hot water) and dishtowels
- Bear scare of some sort – either bear banger or “bear scare” cartridges for a shot gun, as well as the “real thing”
- Satellite phone – the best security for any wilderness trip – can be rented.
- Duct tape for repairs of many kinds
